

How To

Groceries: The nearest grocery store is the Ingles on Sand Hill Rd and Smokey Park Hwy in Candler. To get there, go left on Pisgah Hwy, then make a right on Smokey Park Hwy, turn right in Sand Hill Rd and the Ingles will be on your right hand side. We also have a Dollar General 4.6 miles away on Pisgah Hwy in case you need any supplies.

Gas Station: The nearest gas station is 2.6 miles away on Pisgah Valley Market. Turn left on Pisgah Hwy and the gas station will be .05 miles on your left hand side.

Firepit: Please use good common sense on fire safety! Keep your fire smaller than what the pit can accommodate, you wouldn't want to start a wild fire! If there is kindling and wood stacked out in the back of the cabin, feel free to use it. You can also buy fire wood at any grocery store or gas station. Please be mindful of our plants and take care of them when sitting by the pit. When you're finished, use the hose at the right back side of the cabin to spray down your embers when you're finished. Please don't leave any trash out on the yard.

BBQ: Feel free to use our BBQ on the deck. To turn it on make sure the gas bowl is turned on deck floor by the BBQ. The BBQ tools are on the BBQ. Please make sure you clean the BBQ after every use, we have bears in the area and we wouldn't want them to damage our cabin or disturb your stay.

Trash: Bag and seal all your trash and throw it on out in the outside trash bin near the front of the cabin. Our cleaning crew will pick up the trash can every Monday night or Tuesday morning.

Plumbing: Please be kind to our plumbing system! Do not put food down the kitchen sink and do not flush anything other that human waste down the commodes.

TV's and Soundbar: At the moment we only offer streaming services.

Check In & Out

Check In Instructions:

- The scheduled check-in time is after 4:00 pm.
- There is free parking for up to 3 cars. Please do not park anywhere that's not our cabin designated parking area.
- You'll find clean towels for every guest in each bathroom. You can find extra towels in the upstairs master bathroom.
- If you need to do any laundry, you will have full access to our washer and dryer by the kitchen closet.

Check Out Instructions:

- · Check out is at 10 am.
- · Please leave the house as you generally found it
- If you used dishes, please wash them prior to leaving or start the dish washer.
- Please remove all your belongings and any food (opened or unopened)
- Leave any used towels in a pile on the bathroom floor and strip all the beds that were used.
- All trash must be bagged and placed in the trash can.
- Ensure all the doors and windows are locked.

Downtown Asheville


A lively entertainment hub in the heart of Asheville, filled with shops, farm-fresh restaurants, art galleries, and live music with a mountain vibe.


House Rules
